I promise, upon my Honour that to the best of my knowledge and power, I will not knowingly suffer or pass, or be privy to the passing of Bad Workmanship or Faulty Material in anything and everything that concerns my works as an Engineer.

My Time I will not refuse; **My Thought** I will not grudge; **My Care** I will not deny towards the use, stability and perfection of any works to which I may be called to undertake, be part of or a party to.

My Fair Wages for that work I will openly take. **My Reputation** in my profession I will honourably guard; but I will in no way go about to compass or wrest judgment or gratification from anyone with whom I may deal. And further, I will strive my utmost against professional jealousy or the belittling of my working colleagues, in any field of their labour.

I thus solemnly promise on my Honour to perform to the utmost of my ability as a Registered Engineer of Trinidad and Tobago.
